## Ha-Ha Wall



Following completion of a new neo-classical country house, we constructed a ha-ha wall on the approach to the front of the main house.

Originating from the Inigo Jones era the ha-ha sunken wall was devised so as to maintain unobstructed views between the country house and the grounds. The siting of the wall was intended to nestle between two newly planted beech hedges and blend into the surroundings using reclaimed stone and lime mortar. The project was delivered under budget and on programme.
